TEN REASONS TO JOIN BREVARD ROTARY

- **3. Citizenship in the Community:** Membership in Brevard Rotary makes one a better community citizen. The average Rotary club consists of the most active citizens of any community.
- **4. Continuing Education:** Each week at Brevard Rotary there is a program designed to keep one informed about what is going on in Brevard, our nation, and the world.
